



Curbside Recycling

Orion Township wishes to encourage recycling by all members of our community. According to Township Ordinance No. 73—Solid Waste and Recyclable Material Regulation, participating residents and all trash haulers licensed to operate in Orion Township must abide by the following regulations:

Items That Can Be Recycled:

- Clear glass containers
- Metal food cans and lids
- Aluminum
- Newspapers
- Corrugated cardboard (up to 3' x 3' - bundled)
- Plastic containers—recycling codes 1 & 2

These are the minimum requirements—your hauler may accept more materials—contact them for more information.

Hauler Regulations:

- Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of solid waste collection within Orion Township shall provide curbside/roadside recycling to each single-family and multiple-family residence from which they also collect solid waste, at no additional cost.
- Recyclables must be picked up at least every other week, and on the same day as the solid waste collection.
- The hauler will provide appropriate containers for recyclables to their customers.
- A separate vehicle shall be used to collect recyclables.

The progress of the Township's recycling efforts shall be monitored by the Orion Township Solid Waste/Recycling Committee. The Committee may require periodic reports of the trash haulers to assist in their efforts to promote recycling in the Township.
