Parking Baldwin Plaza Shopping Center

AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT THE PARKING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A MARKED FIRE LANE AND TO RESTRICT THE PARKING OF A MOTOR VEHICLE FROM BLOCKING AN EXIT IN THE PARKING AREA OF "THE BALDWIN PLAZA SHOPPING CENTER" AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by the Public Acts of the State of Michigan in such case, made and provided for the purpose of promoting and protecting the public health, safety, comfort and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Township by regulating and restricting the parking of a motor vehicle in the parking area of the Baldwin Plaza Shopping Center.

Article I

This Ordinance shall be know and may be cited as the Orion Township Baldwin Plaza Shopping Center Parking Ordinance.

Article II

Any person who:

- A. Parks a motor vehicle in a marked fire lane, or
- B. Parks a motor vehicle in a manner which restricts vehicular access to any exit,

in the parking area of the shopping center known as the Baldwin Plaza Shopping Center located at 3010-3046 South Baldwin Road, Orion Township, Michigan, shall be in violation of this Ordinance.

Article III

Exits from the subject parking area shall include the following:

- A. North onto Waldon Road,
- B. East onto Baldwin Road,
- C. South onto the parking area of the adjacent property (2 exits).

Article IV

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a civil infraction, and upon an admission or a finding of responsibility for a civil infraction, the owner or operator of a vehicle involved in the violation shall be subject to reasonable charges for the removal and storage of such vehicle. *(amended 08.15.94)*

Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication, as provided by law.
